Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

In order to make effective use of feedback from our stay at home parishioners, bring our faithful back to experiencing Mass and receiving the Holy Eucharist in their home parish, St. Paul is embarking on a Holy Spirit inspired project motivated by our Patron, St. Paul to “sow generously so we will reap generously”.

We are excited to announce that St. Paul will be installing computer and camera equipment to live stream Sunday 9:30am Mass with drive up Holy Communion from 10:30am-11am.

Adding Live Streaming Mass consistently on a weekly basis makes effective use of technological advances and places a high priority to evangelize our entire community.

The project will require minor construction and minimal investment. You will see a small window being built in choir room so that the controller can see pews while navigating the camera. The camera itself is very reasonable priced and computer is affordable. Close attention to both direct (equipment) and indirect costs (Wi-Fi) have been evaluated. The biggest savings is that our parish staff is doing the installation vs. contracting out and have taken the responsibility to run the live stream.

We are enthusiastic about this opportunity to launch a consistent outreach aligned with Bishop Olmsted’s recent Pastoral Letter announcing his upcoming Exhortation on the Holy Eucharist. The mission is to bring awareness of the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus himself and experience the joys of receiving the Holy Eucharist safely after Mass.

Let us continue to ask for the intercession of our Patron, St. Paul to guide this community in all our endeavors to become “Church of the living God, the pillar and foundation of truth”. (1 Tim 3:15)
